About ABMS Data

ABMS is the official and central registry of certification status information for physicians certified by all 24 ABMS Member Boards. One of the primary functions of ABMS is to communicate the status of physicians' board certification information. ABMS data is widely referenced by professional organizations to confidently confirm a physician's qualifications.

Board certification information from ABMS is considered the "gold standard" for its credibility and quality. The ABMS database, which contains more than 800,000 records, is updated daily with information supplied by the 24 ABMS Member Boards. ABMS makes its data available through print, online and telephone resources for professional and public use.

Physician certification is an important part of constructing a physician's professional profile. Whether your need is to complete hospital privileging requirements or recruit physicians for a public health program, finding complete, quality information can bring peace of mind to your decision making.

Primary Source Professional Services

ABMS data comes directly from the 24 Member Boards. It is considered Primary Source Verified (PSV) only if sourced from specific products and services designated as an *ABMS Official Display Agent* or directly from ABMS or an ABMS Member Board. We have selected specific online services as *Official Display Agents* authorized to supply ABMS data for PSV and non-Primary Source needs. These products and services vary in format, features, functionality, intended application and data update frequency. Reports from these services that include complete certification histories and effective and expiration dates for certification meet the PSV requirements set by The Joint Commission, NCQA, URAC and other accrediting organizations. Information without dates is also available as noted from identified organizations.

Official Display Agents follow specific guidelines to protect the security and quality of the data and to avoid confusion between ABMS data and other, self-reported data. Dates that cannot be verified through the use of the product due to aging data (gaps in update frequency) will not be valid for verification of current board certification status. To verify these certifications, contact ABMS or the certifying ABMS Member Board.

This phone service offers access to the online service for people who do not have a computer. Telephone agents can only confirm a physician's certification from a particular board and in a particular specialty or subspecialty.

The Official ABMS Directory of Certified Medical Specialists® published by Elsevier Inc. in cooperation with ABMS, provides biographical information on physicians who have met the certification requirements of their respective specialty boards. All biographies include type of specialty, subspecialty, if applicable, and the years of certification, subspecialty, re-certification and time-limited certification as appropriate.
