About this Report

The American Board of Medical Specialties® ([ABMS®](#)) is dedicated to improving healthcare through high standards for physician board certification in the United States. Together with its 24 certifying Member Boards, ABMS supports a system of specialty certification that promotes physician excellence, lifelong learning, and professionalism.

The *ABMS Board Certification Report* is a reference resource that presents data compiled from the ABMS Board Certification Database and information provided by the Member Boards. It provides a snapshot of the board certified physician workforce (as of June 30, 2026) and key characteristics including physician distribution by Member Board, specialty, subspecialty, and state.

The ABMS Board Certification Database is a primary source for professional certification verification. Verifying a physician's or medical specialist's board certification is made possible through ABMS public resources and professional services.

The ABMS Data Viewer provides access to aggregated board certification data collected by ABMS and its Member Boards, enabling users to explore and better understand the distribution of board certified physicians and specialists across the United States healthcare system.

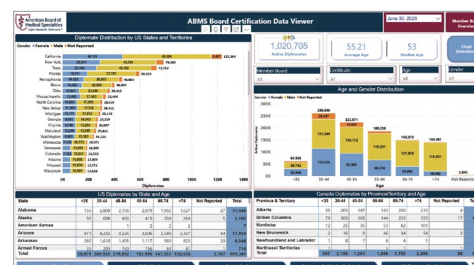
Designed to support exploration and analysis, the tool allows users to examine data related to physicians and specialists certified by ABMS Member Boards across the United States and its territories.

Through a series of interactive dashboards, users can view certification data by geographic region, specialty, and other categories. Filters and customizable views make it possible to explore trends, compare data sets, and focus on specific areas of interest.

Features of the ABMS Data Viewer include:

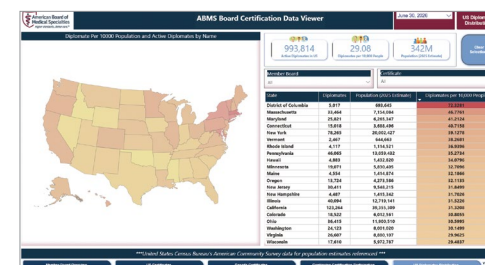
- **Interactive maps** showing the distribution of board-certified physicians and specialists across states and U.S. territories

Throughout the Data Viewer, individuals who hold an active board certification are identified as diplomates. A diplomate is a physician or specialist who has demonstrated expertise in a particular specialty or subspecialty through certification by one of the 24 ABMS Member Boards.



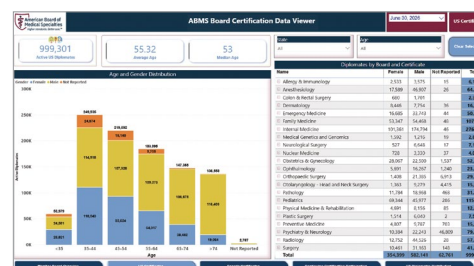

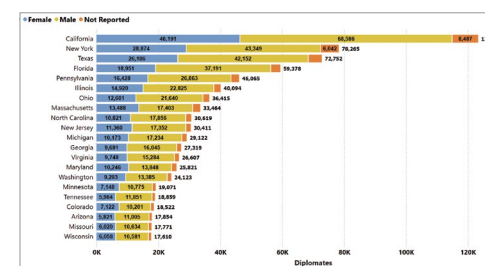
U.S. State Distribution Map

ABMS Board Certified Diplomates: A Population Overview

The 2025–2026 *ABMS Board Certification Report* reflects a growing population of board certified physicians and specialists (also known as diplomates) who use board certification to demonstrate their specialty expertise and continued commitment to provide safe, high-quality, and effective care.

The report shows that as of June 30, 2026 there were 1,020,705 diplomates with an active certification from an ABMS Member Board. Figure 1 shows the counts per board. See [Table 2C](#) for the ABMS Board Certified Diplomates by Member Board and State. The numbers in the table represent distinct counts. A diplomate is counted once per Member Board.

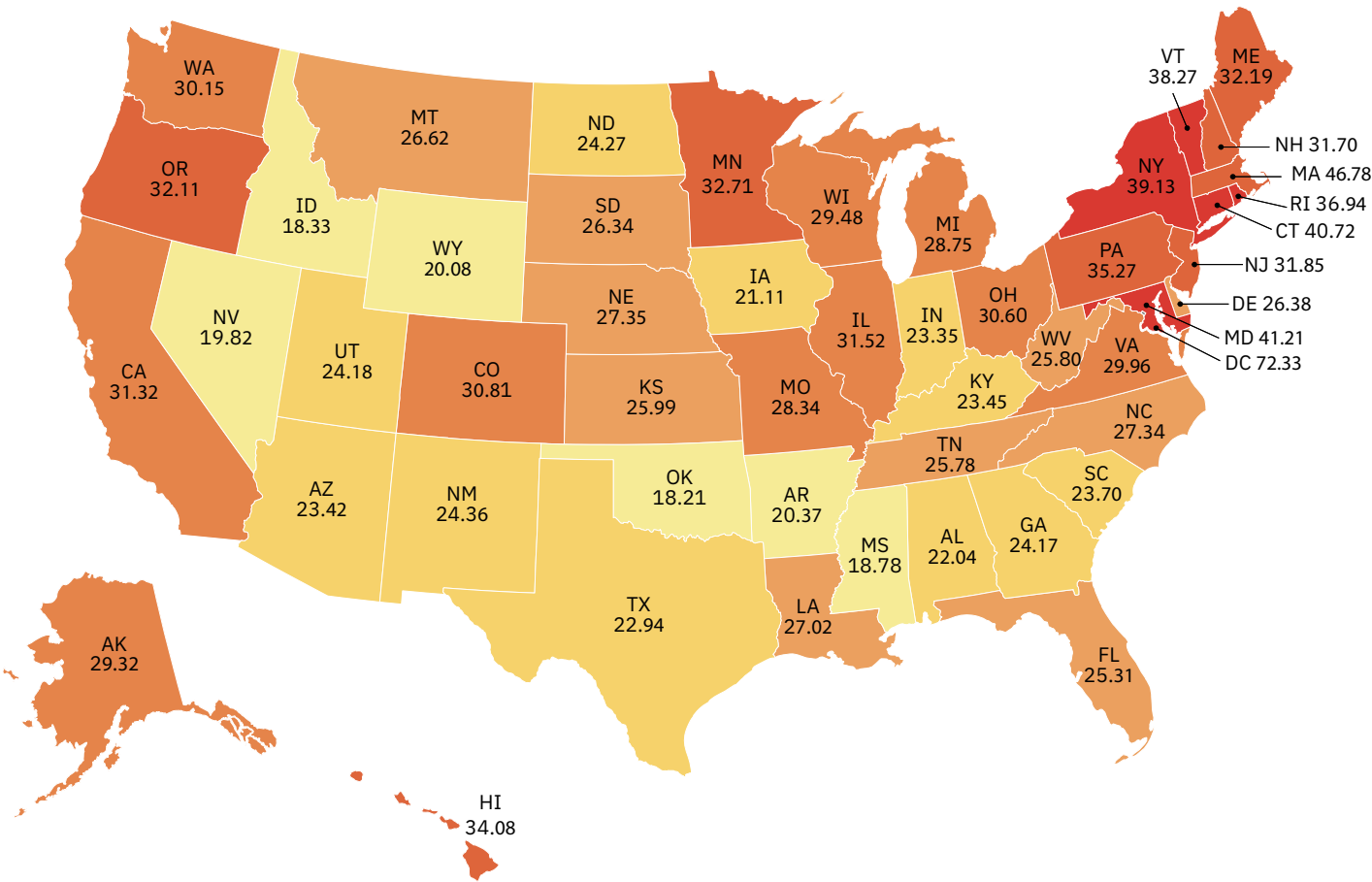

Geographic Distribution of ABMS Member Board Diplomates

Geographic distribution of the ABMS Member Board diplomates was computed using data from the ABMS Board Certification Database, along with the U.S. Census Bureau. ["State Population Totals and Components of Change: 2020–2025."](#) United States Census Bureau, U.S. Department of Commerce, 26 May 2026.

The state totals as of June 30, 2026 in [Table 2C](#) provide information about the distribution of diplomates by Member Board and state. Figure 2 shows the diplomate distribution per 10,000 at the state level.

Age and Gender Breakdown

The breakdown of age and gender for the diplomate population continues to change over time. As shown below, the younger cohort shows an even distribution between men and women in contrast to older cohorts. At this time, 35.3% of all active diplomates are women, while 58.3% are men. Note that 6.3% of diplomates are unknown. Currently the median age of an ABMS board certified diplomate is 53 and the average age is 55.

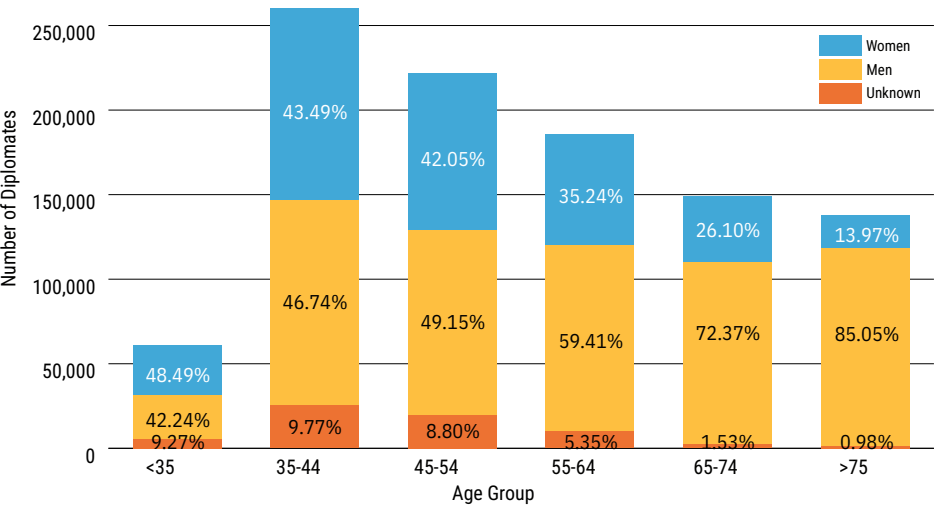

Certifications Awarded

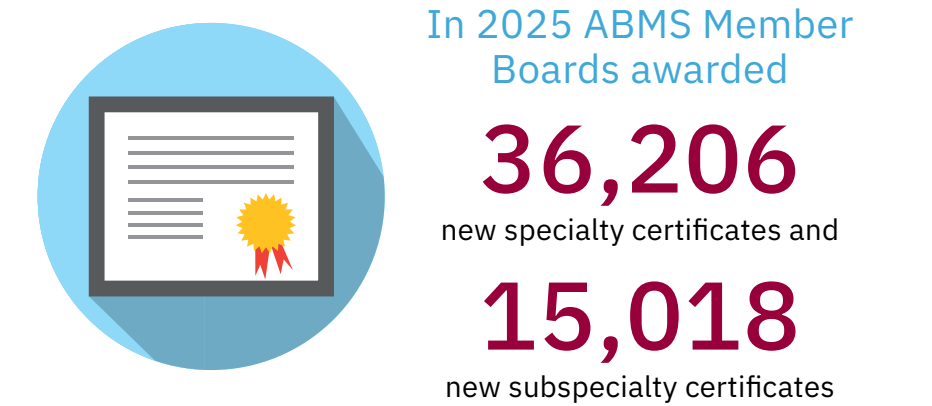


Figure 4: ABMS Member Board Diplomates with Multiple Active Certificates

ABMS Member Boards awarded 36,206 new specialty certificates (see [Table 2A](#)) and 15,018 new subspecialty certificates (see [Table 2B](#)) to physicians and medical specialists during 2025. In looking at the number of active certifications held, many ABMS Member Board diplomates choose to maintain more than one certification to further demonstrate additional specialized medical expertise. Figure 4 shows that about 26% of ABMS Member Board diplomates have at least two active certificates.

Continuing Certification

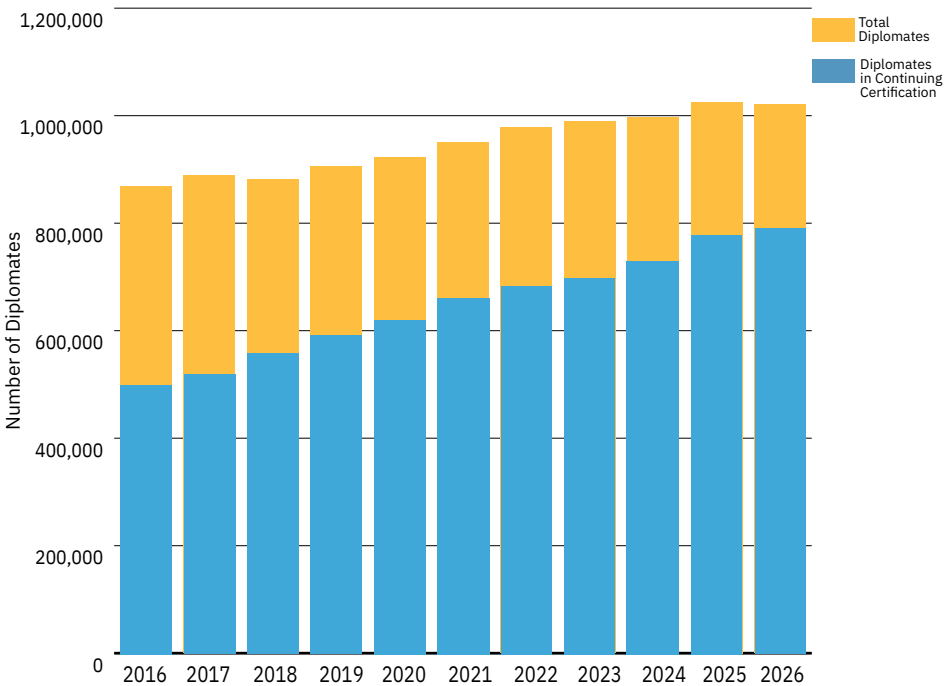
The ABMS Board Certification Database shows that as of June 30, 2026, there were 796,162 diplomates participating in continuing certification. Continuing certification (formerly known as Maintenance of Certification (MOC) is the ongoing process of board certification that simultaneously supports diplomates in keeping their knowledge and skills current while validating their increasing expertise in a specialty.

The process has developed during the last 20 years. Initial certification is the entry point for diplomates to participate in continuing professional development through focused, relevant, and accessible activities and assessments. Board certified diplomates are required to participate in ongoing activities to maintain certification. Some do not, however, because the requirement was not in place when they were first certified. The ABMS Member Boards strongly encourage these individuals to participate voluntarily. Figure 6 shows the increase of the number of ABMS Member Board diplomates participating in continuing certification.

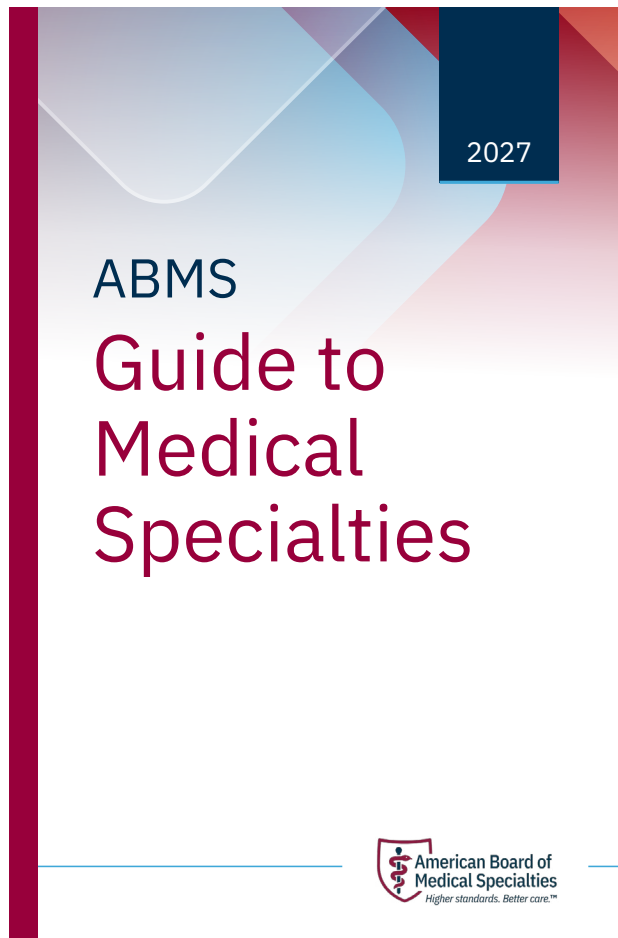
